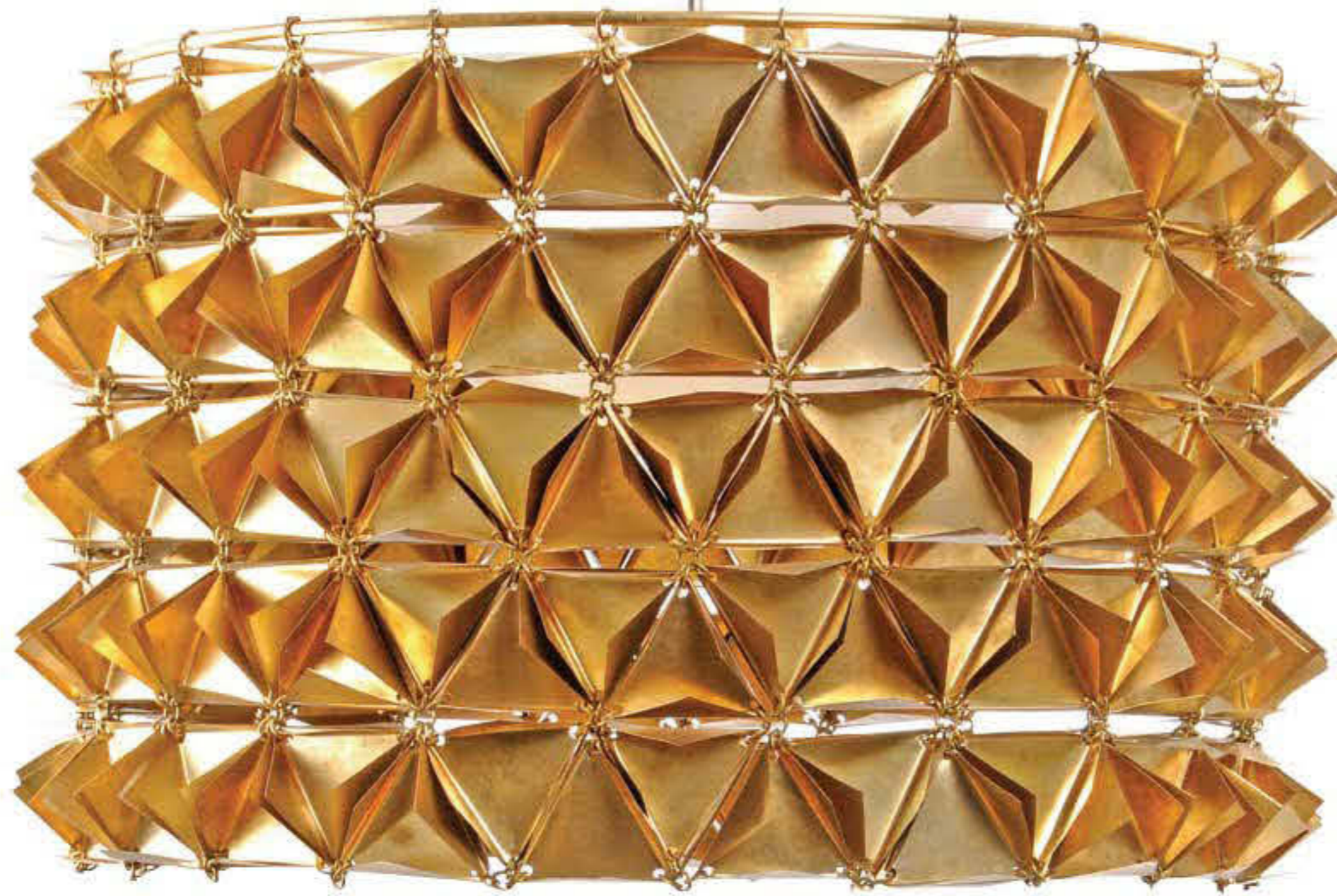


Spend Thrift
