To top it all with extended summers and endless rains, keeping a viable balcony garden is not an easy task. But the benefits that it offers are amazing.

'Masalyu' is a quintessential spice box found in all Indian Kitchens that forms the core of Indian cooking. It is a simplified, functional and an ingenious geometrical circular container that has many cylindrical units that houses a myriad of spices used in Indian cooking. Originally 'Masalyu' was made in Kaasu or Brass, this special copper-tin alloy has been termed-healing metal, by Ayurveda, due to its nutritive and hygiene values. Kansa sharpens our intellect, pays tribute to its therapeutic powers. It also has inherent medicinal properties of the metals from which the alloy is composed. Copper helps in reducing pain, inflammation and improving hemoglobin. Tin is helpful in digestion, relieving headaches and insomnia.

The 'Masalyu' - Spice Matrix has been adapted to encourage storing your freshly picked spices from your herb garden or simply growing your own in one of its larger units. The detachable units are lined with pumice stone - an excellent material that manages water drainage, aerates and prevents root rot. Just remember to never over water and your plants will flourish. Masalyu comes in a series of different metal combination such as Stainless steel, Copper, Kaasu and Brass.

There are many beautifully designed products by other designers, who have tried to solve the issue of gardening for city dwellers in innovative ways. The beautiful designed sculptural watering can by Aldo Bakker will most certainly turn you in to a gardening enthusiast. Bakker allows his products to take shape on the





basis of analysis so that they can question their usage and, where necessary, give rise to new rituals or break existing patterns. This astonishing piece is in perfect harmony with traditional and new production techniques. The Watering Can is very carefully balanced, and is best positioned on silent places like a windowsill. In this way, the Watering Can functions as a border between inside and outside. Yet, the Watering Can can also be laid down. In this

case the little ridges at the opening of the container and the spout prevent the can from spilling water. The shape of the pipe is oval, which emphasizes the iconic and graphic character, in resting position.

Danielle Trophe's 'Vertical garden' is a vertical, self-sustaining planter system that harnesses hydroponic technology making indoor gardening for the space constrained urban dweller an easier and exciting possibility. Its function-forward and aesthetically pleasing design enables people to harness their own green thumb in a modern and exciting new way.
