On completing her Masters from Chelsea College of Art & Design, London, Avni Sejpal tried her creative luck with everything from architecture, furniture, fashion to textile and graphic design. In January 2001, she set up Studio Avni in Vile Parle, Mumbai. She is well known for her geometric lamps. One of her favourite creations is the Faceted Chandelier. "This draws from a modular structure and almost behaves like a free flowing veil," she notes. Her faceted dome lights are based on Buckminster Fuller's geodesic dome, which in her opinion reflects "the very evolution of form." Despite its scientific and complex looking exterior, the entire collection is painstakingly assembled by hand.
