

The idea originated from amethyst rock formations enclosed in large boulders. The refraction of light from these rock light and shadow derivations, in further experimentation, the structure was housed in monolithic volumes that would be strategically fractured revealing a tactile terrain that is ethereal and floaty in nature. The design was developed on a concept of repetitive modules with definitive geometry that can generate different topographical terrains by altering the parameters of each singular module. This

was augmented to merge with the wisay structure and nature of flames in the fireplace and the warmth and semblance it brings to the space around it. Materials such as copper and brass were explored to reflect mellow hues, reflection and purity. This was further elevated to the Indian 'Haxana Kund', meaning holy fire. The light refracted from the copper pixels creates a sentle reddish ambient slow of light. Each pluel goes through a nine-step and assembled. This finally culminates in a form that is unique.
